<u>AGMs</u>

Committees are vital to the running of our 360+ CSPs. Without them, we cannot ensure the student experience you've shaped this academic year. Given the governmental suggestion to practice social distancing, we are advising against in-person AGMs. We are therefore providing an online platform, much like the Leadership Elections, for you to elect your next committee. Here is the timeline for your CSP elections:

All CSPs with vacancies in their Next Year Contact Details (eActivities > Administration > Clubs, Societies & Projects > Documentation > Next Year Contact Details) will be entered in these elections. CSP committees are expected to advertise this to their membership who will be able to submit nominations, manifestos and votes via the Union's <u>website</u>.

If you have already held your AGM in person, please make sure to update the relevant details.

Assessing the financial impact of the coronavirus outbreak
