Let me start by saying I hope you are all well. The situation around Covid-19 is fast-evolving and I am

reaching out to you to give you a further Union update, specific to CSPs.

Yesterday, the government announced new measures to deal with the outbreak of the virus. You will

all have received an email from the College and the Union outlining the position we have taken.

Please find the latest updates from the College here, and from the Union here.

Some of the governmental measures which have been put in place and directly affect CSP activities

include:

• Everyone is advised to avoid unnecessary travel and non-essential contact with others

• Everyone should start working from home where they possibly can

• Anyone who lives with someone who has a cough or a temperature should stay at home for

14 days

• People should avoid pubs, clubs, theatres and other such social venues

In light of these changes and recommendations, we are sadly advising that <u>ALL</u> CSP activity be ceased

with immediate effect until further notice. If you have plans for trips, events or regular CSP activity,

these should be cancelled. Along with Tom Newman (Head of Student Experience) and the Activities

Team, we will still be working full-time to support you as best as we can. Though we will be working

from home, you can still reach us by email.

Many of you will have questions regarding next steps if you have to cancel events or cannot

undertake your activities. We are putting together an FAQ and you can expect email communications

from us every Tuesday as a minimum. As the situation evolves, we will reach out to you on an ad-hoc

basis too if needed.

Many of you have reached out to us about AGMs. We are working with the Systems team to provide

you with an online platform and we will inform you as soon as we have got an adequate solution.

This is a very fast moving situation and an uncertain time for everyone. I understand there will be

financial implications for many CSPs and we are currently working to answer individual queries as well

as devise a plan moving forwards to best support you.

Please look after yourselves and those around you.
