Hello,

If your Club, Society or Project has 140 members or more as at Monday 27 January 2020 00:00, you will be automatically included in the online Leadership Elections 2020 which open at noon, Monday 3 February.

We are aware that there is a very small minority of clubs with exceptional circumstances. If you wish to hold your election offline and you meet one or more of the criteria below, please submit a case for offline elections\* in writing by 23:59 Thursday 30 January 2020.

- 1. Holding your CSP's election online would be detrimental to the attendance of a key event in your CSP's calendar that would otherwise host your CSP's AGM.
- 2. The timetable for the online election would be detrimental to the election of a significant proportion of positions with your CSP, such as for positions relating to organising an event which has not taken place before close of nominations of the Leadership Elections 2020.
- 3. You can evidence that holding elections for your CSP offline at an AGM would deliver a significant benefit to democratic engagement over electing online.

\*Please note that:

- Exceptions can only be made for CSPs below 350 members
- Your CSP must demonstrate it has the logistical capability to hold a free and fair election at an AGM at which all members of the CSP can participate
- Exempt CSPs will be required to operate under the minor elections rules as set out in Section I of the <u>bye-laws of Imperial College Union</u>
- Exempt CSPs will be required to document all processes undertaken in conducting their election to demonstrate conformance with the minor election rules.
- You must inform us of the date and time of your AGM. A Union officer or member of staff may attend as an observer.
- Exemptions are only valid for the Leadership Elections 2020. Positions left vacant will be considered separately for future by-elections.

Any qualifying club with 140+ members by the cut-off date who have not followed the protocol above and have not elected through the online system will automatically have their open positions filled in the next available online by-election.
