### **Club Expectations**

- To have experience in developing novice players' skills and tactical understanding
- Be able to manage a team with a mix of experienced players and novice players.
- Our club aims for all 3 teams to play in a similar way, using the same calls, moves and
  systems across the club, to make it easy for players to progress through all teams as they
  develop. The expectation is for new coaches to be able to buy into this methodology and
  support the head coach in presenting this to the club, but not be afraid to challenge these
  ideas and put new ideas forward within coaching staff discussions.

#### **Main Responsibilities**

- To coach, support and develop a given team(s) within the Imperial Athletes Programme.
- To coordinate with the sports club in delivery of coaching to the specified team (s).
- The coach will be expected to sign and adhere to the Imperial Athletes Club and Coach Agreement and Coaching Service Level Agreement.
- Engage with any Imperial Athletes upskill training and coach workshops.
- To undertake the duties of the post in ways that ensures and enhances the health, safety and wellbeing of students and staff and to promote inclusion and diversity for all sections of the community.
