Felix's production

One issue has been printed so far. We've lost a lot of staff because of exams, so the issues will likely be very small (~20 pages) until the end of term.

Website

The website is finished, and new issues will be going up from now on. In fact, the first one of this term should be up as you read this. I doubt I'll have time to put up all the old issues (some of which only exist in paper form thanks to a server crash during Rupert's period) until the end of the term, because of the aforementioned lack of staff.

Handbook

The handbook needs to be sorted out; last year there were some doubts over the effect of the new Union website on the future of the handbook. For example, is it really necessary to spend as much as the Union does reprinting the blurb off the site for all 280 clubs into the C&S book? I would suggest that, instead, it could be incorporated into the main handbook in the section about joining clubs.

Also, far too many copies were printed last year, meaning the bloody things are hanging around all over the building. I don't have the authority to change any of this, but I do apparently have responsibility for the budget. Making these changes should cut the cost of the handbook almost in half (from around £11k plus £1.5k mailing to about £5k + mailing).
