ACC Wushu Union Gym Relocation Enquiry.

Email from Club;

Hi, I'm the treasurer of Wushu society, I'm just wondering whether there is any opportunities for financial help for the booking of rooms for Ethos?

Recently we were charged £880 for this terms use of Ethos which involved one 2-hour session a week. Since the grant from the union just about covers the instructors fees for this year, this charge will be paid for from most of the SGI we have left over from the previous years that have built up (Initially the union would have been ideal, however due to not being able to find a suitable time slot that agreed with our instructor, we were forced to use Ethos). This isn't sustainable and we hope to be able to use the union next term, but for now is there anything available that can help us pay this?

Conclusions:

Club was lead to believe that the Union gym was not available this term due to the redevelopment, and hence booked Ethos, when this was revealed to be not the case, the particular time slots that would have allowed the club to operate with their instructor, as explained above, were not available. Due to the confusion caused by the relocation and then location back to the union gym, the club was forced to pay for hire of Ethos. This was of course promised by the former DPCS to be covered by the union redevelopment money, which now has disappeared.

Proposal:

CSB to provide the ACC, and then Wushu with the £880 for the ground hire cost that was charged to the club, money that was promised by the former DPCS, from the CSB contingency fund.
