Mountaineering Storeroom

A Paper by the Deputy President (Finance & Service)

Currently, the Mountaineering Club occupy a storeroom in the West basement which is underutilised. With the continual demand on club and society storage facilities, and with a massive reduction in space during the building project, it was suggested that the mountaineering storeroom should be reduced in size to allocate space for another group.

After consultation with the club and assurances that they would have space to relocate to during the building works, a quote was obtained to divide the storeroom into two halves and install a separate locking door.

With the space generated it would be possible to move a large volume of storage from the East Basement into the new storeroom, for example, the ACC Rugby, Football and Netball store which currently occupies a very small (and smelly) room behind the Student Activities Centre. This has additional benefits as it means that the clubs that are most likely to use the laundry facilities in the East basement are located in close proximity.

Decision Required

1) To allocate a maximum of £1,800.00 (excluding VAT) of Executive Reserve for the work to be completed in the mountaineering storeroom.
