There haven't been major problems due to the work occurring, however the finance system used which interacts with both the database and the club transaction pages has been creating problems of its own. Part of my time is helping the Business System Consultant trying to work out solutions to them, this has now involved a number of trips to ICT to try and sort out the various problems. The main problem is how long queries take to run; this has ramifications to any online club transaction page which needs queries to run instantly instead of the eight minutes which I have seen. There is a solution now I view and we just need to persuade ICT to agree to it.

I have also started to transfer the database which looks after the minibus booking system and so the minibus pages will be updated as soon as bookings are put in and changed instead of a batch upload.
