Collections and cloakrooms

Through running collections (tube stations) and cloakrooms (for Masquerade Ball and Graduation) RAG has raised a total of £718.18. In the next couple weeks RAG will be collecting at the Albert Hall (17th December) and with IC Choir at Borough Market (12th December). These collections have raised money for Shelter, Barnardos and The Rainbow Trust.
