Exec Reserve

The Exec Reserve for 2008/09 is made up of the Clubs and Societies underspend from the previous year (not including unspent equipment grant for that year). The need to bring Clubs and Societies admin online is ever increasing and it is my aim to start with the introduction of an online budgeting process this year.

Trading

The bar prices, regrettably, have had to be raised by roughly ten percent this summer in order to accommodate inflation and rising cost prices. We have managed to keep most of



the popular ales at the same price as last year. The new prices are still amongst the cheapest of the London Student Union's and the surrounding area.

Da Vincis and dB's have both seen a refurbishment which has transformed the atmosphere of both bars. The old décor was in much need of touching up and the new look is intended to last until Phase 3 of the Beit Redevelopment is implemented.

Vans

The Union has recently purchased four new fifteen seater minibuses; this is in addition to the four purchased the year before and one slightly older nine seater. We therefore currently service 9 functional minibuses at South Kensington and an additional even older seventeen seater at Silwood. There are imminent plans to buy a new fifteen seater for Silwood bringing our total number of vans to eleven.
