Handbook and Communications

New Website!

As part of my plan to reinvigorate our infrastructure I have embarked on a website redevelopment. Phase one of this is almost complete. The website is completely new. Our aim was to create a better platform to interact with our students whilst increasing the flexibility the website making it easier to use and improve. We believe that we have successfully completed these aims. This website should serve the RCS well in the future. The new website is experiencing heavy traffic several times greater than the old website received at this point in last year.

This has come about because of a great deal of interest in us getting some basic regalia. Soon we shall have tie and shirts these will be of the same design as old RCS regalia. We have been tracking down RCS regalia through the RCSA and archives.
