Accounts

Last Tuesday the Union Sub Audit Committee met, where we reviewed the statutory accounts for last year. The decision was to recommend approval to the Trustee Board. Jen, the Union HST and I will present the accounts to the College Audit Committee on Wednesday. Further to this the accounts will need to go to College Council before the whole process is wrapped up.

Clubs and Societies

The beginning of October has been hectic with day to day admin and club enquiries, things have started to die down now people seem to be in the swing of things.

Tours

We have had a large number of clubs apply to our now hugely increased tours fund. In an attempt to make the allocation of funds fairer, the IC Trust are no longer funding individual tour applications. Instead they will donate £19500 a year to the Union Tours Fund which more than doubles our £16000 kitty. Due to this increase CSB voted to raise the funding cap from 32% to 40% which meant a change to the operational policy.

Clubs Budgeting

Its getting nearer the time when we start to think about the annual budgeting round for clubs. I have been working with our Systems Manager to create an online budgeting system which is almost ready for testing. The Arts and Ents board has kindly agreed to suffer the testing process, which I hope will begin in the next week or two.

Events

I have received many budgets for upcoming events over the coming year, the vast majority seem to be planning very well. Keep them coming!

Trust funding

I have been reviewing applications to the IC Trust and I'm pleased to say that more clubs than usual have been applying. For more information on the IC Trust and how to apply type IC Trust into the college website.

The DPCS and I met to review club debts last week, it appears there are a number of clubs who's accounts still hold deficits. I won't name and shame them here, but we are working with the clubs to provide an easy solution for them to repay their debts whilst still operating successfully as a club.

Progress on the Summer Ball continues, an initial budget has been written and we are already in communication with different areas of college regarding their input.
