**TOUR PURPOSE**

We plan a winter tour to Yorkshire to train the newest members of the club up to an international standard, as to benefit most from our more serious Spring term trips and international tours in Easter. Yorkshire offers over 200 serious caves, a lot of which are outside the scope of our weekend trips either due to the length and seriousness of the undertaking, or due to restricted land access arrangements. Its for this reason that we have special cave permits (to Leck fell for example) to allow for unique trips to take place usually unavailable to us.

We plan to book the UZX (9 seater minibus) with which to transport our caving equipment and the majority of members. We also plan to hire cars externally in order to transport everyone who we expect to come while retaining the flexibility to run a variety of different trips to different caves in different parts of the country. We will be staying at the Northern Pennine Club caving cottage, which keeps costs for heated accommodation down to a minimal £4.50 pp pn, while providing the facilities necessary to clean and prepare caving equipment.

The unique, tour nature, of this proposal is in the caves entered and caving undertaken rather than the logistics or area that we visit. This provides an opportunity for new members to do as much caving in a week as they have in an Autumn of weekend trips, and allows them to hone their skills and prepare for the deep Alpine caves which we enter and explore in Spring & Summer, forming an essential cornerstone of our year-round training.

All accommodation, transfers and catering in J'Burg is to be paid by the Festival Organisers.
