Imperial College Union Court Appointments Proposed by the President, Seconded by the Executive Committee

Background

The ICU Court is composed of three groups of people:

- Three life members, nominated by the Executive and approved by the Council
- Three full members, nominated by the Executive and approved by the Council
- Three full members, one from each Faculty, elected by the Council

The three life members serve terms of three years, which expire in consecutive years. The life members are currently Alex Grisman (expires 2012), Hamish Common (expires 2011) and Rob Park (expires 2010).

The terms for the full members expire on the 31st July every year, however nominated members may be re-appointed without the Executive having to consider them again.

I am asking, on behalf of the Executive Committee, for Council to appoint or re-appoint a number of people on Court. There will, additionally, be elections for the elected positions.

Appointment of a new Life Member

Rob Park's term as a life member comes to an end this year. The Executive Committee have nominated Stephen Brown as his replacement on Court.

Stephen was ICU President in 2007-2008 and now works at Deloitte.

Appointment of new Full Members

Elly Jay and Alex Guite are standing down as members of Court, so are not seeking re-appointment. The Executive Committee has recommended Mark Chamberlain and Karl Bonney to take their places.

Mark is this year's Council Chair, was previously the ICSMSU President and will be entering his sixth and final year of Medicine next year.

Karl is a previous Media Group chair and is currently undertaking a PhD in Chemistry.

Re-appointment of Nominated Members

The Executive Committee has previously nominated Jarlath Molloy to the Court. Council is invited to re-appoint him.

- 1. To appoint Stephen Brown as a new life member of the Court, his term to run from 1st August 2010 to 31st July 2013.
- 2. To appoint Mark Chamberlain and Karl Bonney to the Court, their terms to run from 1st August 2010 to 31st July 2011.
- 3. To re-appoint Jarlath Molloy to the Court.
