General Meeting Announcement
A note by ICU President – Scott Heath

Background

1. On Friday March 2, in the Felix comment piece titled 'It's time for a Union General Meeting' I announced my desire to call a General Meeting.
2. The Constitution permits a General Meeting to be called by the President and, as such, I provide the Council with notice of my intention to do so.
3. The date has yet to be finalised however it will either be at the end of May or the beginning of June, in order to provide enough time for the amended constitution to go to the Trustee Board and Imperial College Council.
4. The General Meeting will be called to pass an amended Constitution which will seek to change elements of:
 - i. The Trustee Board Membership [Regulation 1];
 - ii. The Executive Committee [Regulation 5];
 - iii. The Council Membership [Regulation 5];
 - iv. The Welfare and Representation Board [Regulation 5];
 - v. The Job Descriptions for the Sabbatical Officers [Regulation 3];
 - vi. The Representation Structure;
 - vii. The Financial Regulations [Regulation 8];
 - viii. The Election Procedures [Regulation 4].

There may also be minor amendments and tidying up of other regulations and the Constitution on the whole.

5. All members of Council will be encouraged to come and shall receive the document describing the changes prior to general circulation.
