## SUMMARY OF CSC ACTIVITIES

So far the first term has been a successful one and no huge problems have occurred. With continued support from the St. Mary's Association and the ICSM Alumni Association we are trying to find more income for clubs. We are also in talks with the Faculty's Finance department to allow not only the ICSMSU Exec to be more profitable with events, but hopefully open up venues and ideas for clubs to bring in extra income

The ICSM Gazette has been very successful so far. They have exceeded their membership targets and copies of the Gazette can be found in the majority of campuses. They have quite a big following on Facebook and their websites receives a substantial number of hits.

During Fresher's Fortnight 2 key events revolved around clubs and societies; Freshers Fayre and Sport's Day. The fayre was very successful with the SAF building busy all day. The Sport's Day was held in Teddington and was also greatly received. With the help of club captains and volunteers over 60 1<sup>st</sup> Years enjoyed the facilities of Teddington, and had their first taste of ICSM sports clubs.

## FINANCIAL REPORT & MEMBERSHIP

Overall the vast majority of ICSMSU Clubs & Societies appear to be financially with no group complaining about frozen accounts due to lack of documentations. Membership is generally quite good in comparison to last years although some clubs/socs are being looked at very closely over the next few weeks, the main one being ICSM sub-aqua.

## CLUB CONSTITUTION CHANGES

No clubs have requested to change their constitution. The majority have theirs online. I am chasing the ones who have yet to submit anything. ICSM Gazette is in the process of submitting a constitution.

## NEW CLUBS

Very few proposals have come directly to myself asking for advice. ICSM SORA was approved by NCC and should be up and running very soon. ICSM Careers Soc has a promising career as we have spoken to all clubs that would be involved and the majority are happy to become an umbrella society. ICSMSU President Shiv Vohra is in the process of finalising all the details with ICU.

## EXEC ACTIVITIES

The ICSMSU website is constantly being maintained and updated thanks to our Communications Officer Giada Azzopardi. It contains a huge amount of information from events to all links/contact for the clubs and socs and useful contact details. The note bank has proven to be very successful and appreciated by students, particularly years 1 and 2.

Fresher's Fortnight was an a huge hit with the Freshers and was a financial success for ICSMSU. Whether it was our black tie ball, the pirate themed boat party or our annual Reynolds Beach bop everyone had a great time. 1 or 2 problems occurred with venues (particularly the boat party) but this was quickly resolved thanks to our Entertainment team.

RAG has had a strong start to the year. With 3 events, included the very well attended Centurion, things are looking very promising. Our RAG Chair Shoib Rizi has been working very hard. No doubt that next term's RAG Week will be very well attended alongside RAG Dash (to Amsterdam).

The last Exec event of the year will be held on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2012. Known as 'The Snow Ball' nearly 400 tickets have been sold and is already looking to be successful (financially and in attendance).

The Reynolds has been through it's first phase of redevelopment which included removing old furniture, changing the old wall panels and redoing the floor. The 2<sup>nd</sup> phase will be commencing in the near future although exact details are currently being discussed between Shiv and the Faculty. Discussions on when to get permanent furniture for the Reynolds are also on going.

## CONTINGENCY AWARDS

So far this year no-one has applied for contingency funding.

## TOURS

Netball, Football, Rugby, Men and Ladies Hockey, Music Society, Lacrosse, Water polo, Darts and Light Opera have all been on tour so far this year. From the information I have received from members they were very successful and no problems occurred.

## SOCIAL

As with other years bops are being held in the Reynolds to aid clubs in raising money for specific causes and promoting their club. The Halloween bop reached Reynolds capacity and this years Christmas bop (hosted by Football) will almost certainly do the same.

## PARTICULAR ISSUES

There has only been one major issue so far:

- BUCS – Despite countless debate and consultation it seems BUCS have not accepted Imperials proposal (or any other universities proposal for that matter). We are currently seeking advice on what the next step should be and should have useful information in the new year.

## FACILITIES/STORAGE

Clubs and Societies continue to use space in the Reynolds Building for storage. So far there have been no reports of any problems in this area and it will be continued to be monitored.
