<p>*Contrary to the form details, our leaving date is Friday 22nd 15.00 as the division between winter and spring tours is split between 22nd/23rd. We will be leaving Nottingham 20.00 on Sunday 24th returning to London at 2am on Monday 25th March as the form states. I was not able to select Friday 22nd from the list.</p> <p>We will be entering the British Open 2013 Nationals Cheer & Dance Championships on 23rd and 24th March at the Capital FM Arena, Nottingham. This will be the first time we enter this competition and the first time we compete in this location. We will pay the World Cheerleading Coalition (ICC) £2306.00 for entrance fees for our members (52 x £38 normal fee, 15x £22 Partner Stunt Fee).</p> <p>This year we have two competition squads (21 and 31 members) and we are bringing three external unpaid coaches with us, total 55 people. We have booked both the coach travel and the hotel. We will be leaving Friday 22nd March at 15.00 from near Heathrow, where we are hiring a spring floor gym in the morning as a dress rehearsal for the competition. This venue will cost us (5x£20/hr) £100 total. We will stay in Nottingham for two nights and leave at 8pm on Sunday 24th arriving at 2am on Monday. We are travelling on a 72 seater coach as this was the best deal we could find in order to transport the whole team. We will be staying at Jurys Inn Nottingham for 2 nights (22nd and 23rd) for £3648.00.</p> <p>British Open Nationals is the one competition we will be participating in this academic year due to the expenses for the club and its members, and it is the event that we work towards all year. Our 31-member squad will compete at Allstar Level 3 and the 21-member team will compete at Allstar Level 2. Both teams are aiming to place within TOP6 and win a trophy against around 20 teams per category. We are entering three 5-member groups for Partner Stunt University Open Level, from which we aim to bring back at least one trophy.
