

Allocation of Uncoded Start up Grant

Background

As part of an application to the New Clubs Committee proposer can ask for a start-up grant to fund initial activities and the purchase of essential equipment. The New Clubs Committee then decide how much to allocate the group from a pot allocated to them by the Clubs and Societies Board.

During handover an email was sent detailing grant allocations to new projects and clubs for those made during the year. These clubs and allocations are detailed below.

- Kite surfing were created in the May 2012 New Clubs Committee and assigned £500.
- Student Action for Refugees (STAR) were created in the May 2012 New Projects Committee and assigned £100.
- TEAM Student were created in February 2012 New Projects committee and assigned £50.
- Project Nepal were created in November 2011 New Projects committee and assigned £50.

Unfortunately none of these allocations were coded last year and the funds moved to the Union surplus as part of year end. A copy of the Clubs and Societies Board accounts can be seen below.
