

#### **Overview**

2014 has been a great year for the RCC, with existing clubs thriving and even some new ones making an appearance.

Building on a the work done by last year's committees, the new club committees have hit the ground running and brought a strong start to the academic year. Many have expanded their activities, with some clubs reaching unprecedented levels of membership. In general, smoothly running club administration, and strong financial stability have also been the norm for RCC clubs this year.

Just two RCC clubs have not yet found a committee for the new year, but both are organising elections at the moment to remedy this.

As the surrounding photos (from just the last few months) attest, a huge effort by the members of these clubs has led to a great range of well-attended events.

With the RCC providing the most diverse range of activities on offer at Imperial, this fantastic start to the year has meant an enriched student experience for the (still increasing) 2,300 members of the RCC.

Points where clubs have encountered problems related to Union operations, however, include:

- Unavailable/overcrowded storage
  - Abuses of storage space by other users (lack of tidiness/damage to items)
  - Items going missing from storage
- Significant delays with processing of Union finances, and with query-resolution regarding finance problems
- Minibus unavailability

We also store sensitive documentation in our safe after first aid duties, and a security breach here could result in legal action from casualties.</li> <li>We have recently acquired two expensive training AEDs, which were originally planned to be stored in a secure locker provided by the college. The locker has since been removed without our consent. The AEDs represent a significant investment on the part of the society, and have already proven their worth not only in our own meetings but also with various other societies, thus we require secure storage for them.</li> <li>We need an urgent review of our storeroom arrangements.</li> </ul>



One of our instructors was diving in 20m with a sports diver trainee (SDT) and with a newly qualified sports diver (NQSD). The NQSD had trouble with his primary regulator underwater - it was leaking water and giving a 'wet breathe'. He carried on the dive for a while, as the problem got worse. When it got too bad, he signalled 'out of gas' to the instructor. The instructor gave the NQSD his alternate air source (AS), and all three divers ascended in a normal fashion to 6m. They then conducted a safety stop together. During that safety stop, the instructor set off a delayed surface marker buoy (DSM)B using the NQSD's AS (which was still functioning fine), and after having done so he passed the DSMB to the SDT. After the safety stop, they all ascended to the surface together.

One of our instructors was diving in low visibility in about 15m of water. He was diving with two students, one of whom was wearing a borrowed drysuit. Both students were relatively new and inexperienced divers. The instructor was in eye contact with both students. He noticed that one of the students was having some buoyancy issues and had ascended slightly off the bottom. As this first student appeared to be getting back in control of his buoyancy, the instructor turned to check the second student. However, when he looked back to the first student, he was just disappearing from sight towards the surface some distance above the instructor. The instructor reacted quickly and properly, and he and the second student made an ordinary ascent to the surface to rejoin the first student.

The first student had encountered buoyancy issues in his borrowed drysuit. In previous dives he had experienced some suit squeeze, so he had put more air into his drysuit this time to compensate. He said he felt 'floaty', and found himself unable to dump air sufficiently fast. The result is that he made a rather uncontrolled, but not too rapid, ascent to the surface. He arrived headfirst (i.e. not inverted). He surfaced a minute or so before the instructor and the second student.

The boat reacted quickly and properly. No symptoms of decompression illness were identified, but the first student was put on O2 as a precaution. Medical advice was that he did not need treatment in a recompression chamber, but should wait 24 hours before diving again.

In most of our diver training courses, some basic first aid related to diving and rescue management are covered, so even though we don't have a large number of fully qualified first aiders, we have the capability to carry out first aid for the diving that we do.

This was a major problem during taster sessions, as more than 50 people turned up to each session but we had to turn people away due to lack of space.</li> <li>Our pilates instructor had an invoice in June that was not paid until this week. The union finance administrators have been slow in responding to enquiries and not forthcoming with regards to payment date.</li> <li>We received a Harlington Grant in October, however the money is still not in our account</li> <li>Our secretary quit his studies during the summer, so we had to wait until the start of term to hold an EGM so that we can elect a new secretary. This made life very difficult in the first few weeks as we had to share responsibilities (e.g. answering emails, organising meetings) between the rest of the committee members</li> <li>In St Mary's, the union provided no help in booking rooms or arranging storage. We had to contact different departments to find out who was in charge of booking which rooms.</li> </ul>
