1. Key Points

- **1.1.** Two management group meetings have been held this term, and a third is planned for later this month. Both were reasonably well-attended, although attendance could have been improved in both cases.
- **1.2.** It's been a mixed year for the SCC. It was only at the end of January 2014 that an SCC Chair for the 2013/14 academic year was elected the one elected at the 2013 AGM had to step down from the role around October 2013.
- **1.3.** Furthermore, for the first half of this term there was no treasurer due to the previous one stepping down. A new one was elected at the November SCC meeting.
- **1.4.** Last term three clubs were shut down for various reasons; many more were placed into dormancy and then removed from dormancy after making the necessary improvements.
- 1.5. This term several new clubs were created. They are all at varying stages of development.
- **1.6.** In general, the SCC is a very diverse management group, encompassing everything from faith groups, to political groups, to Science Fiction & Fantasy, to Cheese to Finance. It is also the largest in the Union, with 60 clubs & societies (no projects) making it hard to intimately

know everything about every club outside of the ones you've resolved queries for and the ones you've been directly involved in. It also makes it hard to tailor meetings to the specific needs of a certain type of club, and to write a detailed breakdown of every club's wellbeing here

- **1.7.** Some contingency claims were made last academic year. None have been completed so far this term.
- **1.8.** Other than that nothing major has happened to us specifically.

2. Clubs with causes for concern

- 2.1. There are currently several clubs with no committee members: Fairtrade (who also have no members currently), Innovation (despite having over 70 members), Philosophy (50 members), Wikipedia (20 members). I have been following these up the clubs listed here are the ones I haven't sorted out yet.
- **2.2.** Advertising Society and Buddhist Society did have no committee but this has now been resolved and they now have committees. (Advertising Society still has other problems I am investigating.)
- **2.3.** See first attached table for naughty officers, outstanding training quizzes, etc.
- **2.4.** Besides the clubs with no committees, a few clubs didn't attend either SCC meeting this term. I have followed up with all of these clubs now (besides the ones listed above who don't have committees).
- **2.5.** Besides these issues, no clubs have major debt issues or any other causes for concern, to the best of my knowledge.

3. Membership

3.1. See first attached table at the bottom for membership level versus target membership for this year.

4. Finances

- **4.1.** See second attached table for a finance breakdown.
- **4.2.** Besides that, here are some key points:
 - **4.2.1.** Only two clubs are in the red, both of which are new clubs which haven't had access to budgeting yet, and both of which are only £20 in the red approximately.
 - **4.2.2.** Two clubs have no records: Advertising Society, which I am currently investigating as outlined above, and Friends of MSF, who have only just been revived and who I have yet to get in touch with.
 - **4.2.3.** A few other clubs have £0.00 for various reasons. I am looking into these issues.
 - **4.2.4.** Other than them all clubs appear to be fairly healthy. Finance Society, as usual, has the largest budget in the SCC, as is to be expected. However this year a new club, the Oil & Gas Forum, have a comparable amount to Finance, which is almost unheard of for the SCC.

5. Management Group Restructuring

5.1. I have been in discussions with the DPCS and other Management Group chairs about the possible restructuring of management groups this year. These talks have been quite fruitful, with many suggestions raised, some of which seem fairly plausible/doable.

6. Tours

- **6.1.** Many clubs submitted tour requests last academic year. Most were successful. All necessary tour reports have been submitted.
- **6.2.** Three clubs submitted tour requests this term. All three were approved, but two were queried along similar lines.
- **6.3.** The queries related to the issue of how well the tours aligned with the clubs' aims & objectives, as opposed to the tour being merely to socialise. It was pointed out in the meeting that as social clubs our aims & objectives, mostly *are* about socialising. This point was met with agreement at the subsequent SCC meeting, and raised as an issue in discussions about changes to the tours policy this term. The clubs in question were also informed of this to help them in future applications.

7. Club feedback

- **7.1.** I had limited feedback from clubs before writing this report, but here is some of the feedback I did receive:
- **7.2.** There was general complaining about the room booking system. For example, Consultancy society complained that often speakers from firms are very last minute in giving them requests, and the popularity of the firm determines the room size they need, making the current system fairly troublesome for them.
- 7.3. One new society (London Forum for Science & Policy) complained about the lack of decent introductory materials for new clubs. Despite attending all of the club officer training, the chair has protested to me that the whole Union process can be rather daunting, with 30+ page training materials that few people actually read. He also suggested a general 'eActivities for Dummies' guide might be useful (my words, not his). He also thought it would be good to have more workshops for club officers, and training on how clubs can run workshops themselves.
- **7.4.** A separate new society (Tea) complained about not having access to any Union funding due to being created after budgeting but before contingency opened and before the Activities Development Board met for the first time, i.e. they needed money before the start of term, in the run-up to Freshers' Fair.
