New Activities Committee

The New Activities Committee has now met for the second time, this time with clubs in a face-to-face setting. The outcome of the meeting on the 6th November was 2 new clubs, 1 new club progressing out from the New Club Incubator, and 6 new clubs in the New Club Incubator.
