Introduction

Over the last couple of years this club has struggled to attract much interest. Last year no AGM was held and thus no committee elected for the present year. Stephen Ball sent an e-mail to all current members of the society asking whether anybody would be interested in reviving the society but no answer was received. Club Status

The club is currently classified as Dormant, although it currently has 40 full members although this can be attributed to it not charging any membership fees.

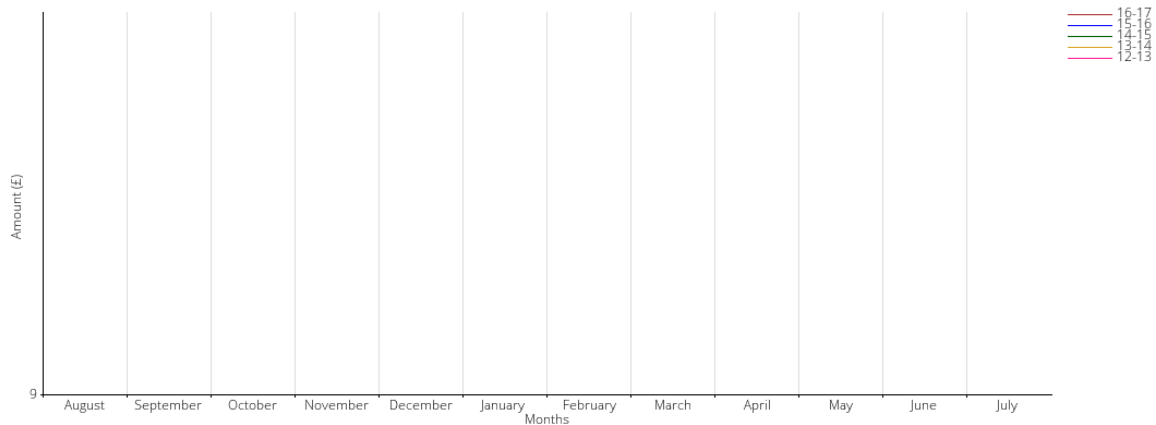


Figure 1: Recent financial activity of RCC Linux Users Group

Currently the club has £9.00 in its account, and as [Figure 1] shows there has been very little financial activity in the club over the previous five years.
