TEF - Provider Submission

ICU Notes:

- 1. The Higher Education and Research Bill (HERB).
- 2. That a written submission will form part of each higher education provider's Teaching Excellence Framework (TEF) submission.
- 3. That College has invited ICU to contribute to its TEF provider submission.
- 4. That the primary initial legislative impact of TEF ratings will be to determine which universities are permitted to increase their tuition fees.
- 5. That existing union policy, backed by member polling, is opposed to the marketisation of higher education and the raising of tuition fees.

ICU Believes:

- 1. That as the TEF provider submission is a new process, engaging with it is an active choice rather than maintenance of the status quo.
- 2. That the TEF provider submission is effectively a "sales pitch" for the ability to increase tuition fees, rather than an investigative process.
- 3. That our responsibility to accurately represent members' teaching concerns is incompatible with contribution to such a document.
- 4. That actively choosing to assist in a process which seeks to justify increased tuition fees is incompatible with union policy and the wishes of our members.

ICU Resolves:

1. To respectfully decline to contribute to College's TEF provider submission.
