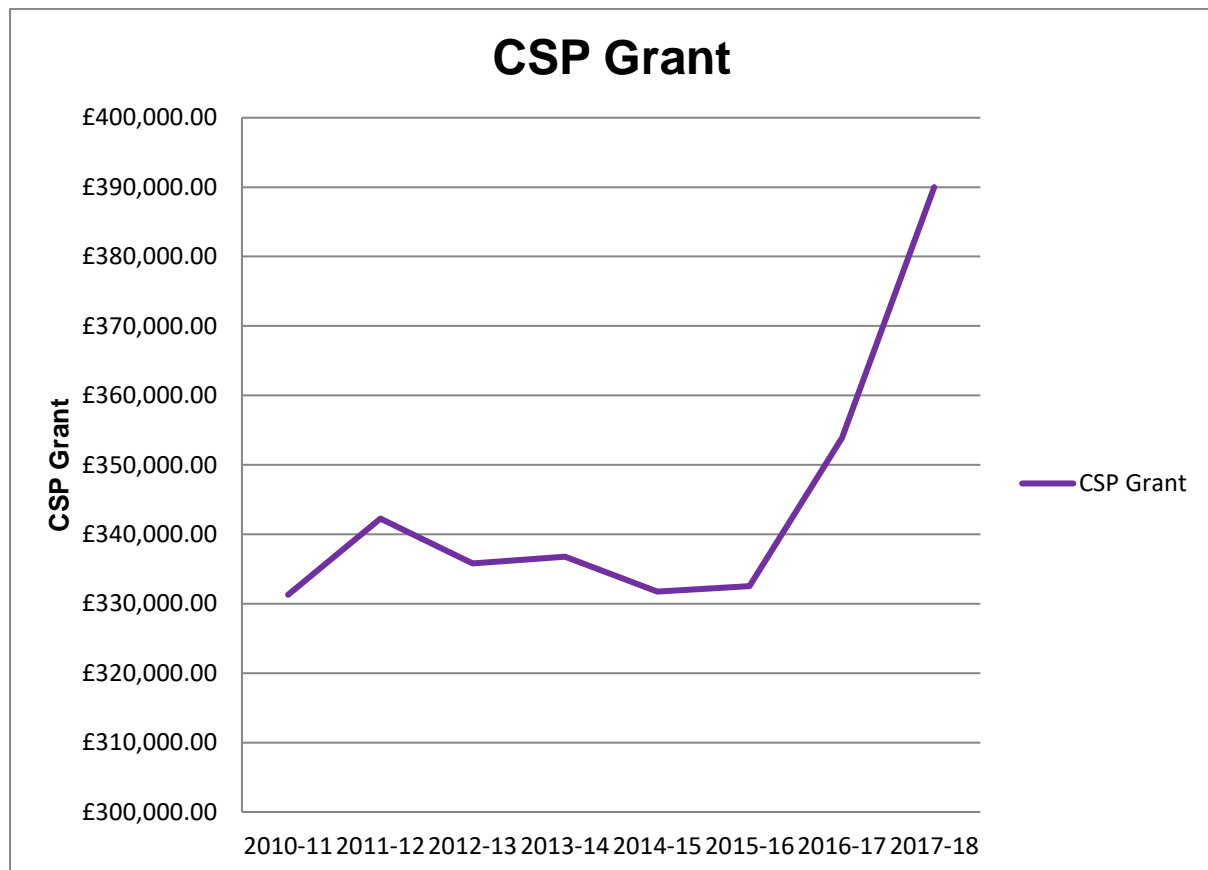


CSP Funding

Apologies for the appendix, I was waiting until after the strategy launch to announce this. CSP Grant has increased to £390,000 for 17/18 (distributing this year through annual budgeting).
