TITLE	Investment Strategy Update

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY	Following the formation of the investment strategy panel at the Finance and Risk Committee (F&R) in January 2018, the panel has met twice with the Katrina Brown, the consultant acting on our behalf, from Independent Investment Reviews. Neil Sachdev has stepped down from the panel and has been replaced by the Graham Parker the current chair of F&R. A long list of 11 potential fund managers was reviewed by the panel in order to generate a short list of 3. Presentations from the perspective fund managers are due to take place on morning of 24 April. Matt Blackett, the Deputy President (Finance and Services), has initiated an open discussion process to canvass the views and opinions of our members via an online interactive survey. A shortlisting summary report is attached. The panel is expecting to make a decision by the end of the 3 presentations.
PURPOSE	A verbal update will be provided to F&R. Committee members are to be assured that the panel have carefully considered the impact of an ethical overlay on the risk of investing.
