

Imperial College Union Combining SPB and SHE to reform CSPB Union Council / September 30th 2021

Purpose: To propose a change in the structure of subcommittees of council relating to

Clubs and Societies

Decision: To approve the appropriate changes to Appendix B of the Standing orders of

Council.

Union Notes

1. Prior to the 20/21 academic year, the Clubs, Societies and Projects board met as one sub-committee of Council. Last year, the structure was changed to separate the Sports Clubs into the Sports Hub Exec (SHE) and the Societies and Project Board (SPB).

- 2. They primarily held meetings together over the year, with SPB rarely meeting without members of SHE in attendance. SHE held more regular meeting than SPB.
- 3. Both groups allocate funding to the student led groups. We have a legal responsibility to ensure a fair process of funding allocation.

Union Believes

- 1. The two committees have a significant overlap in their remit.
- 2. SPB held policies that were also expected to apply to SHE.
- 3. It is important to ensure equal oversight and accountability of all Management Groups.
- 4. Having these groups separate creates the possibility of unequal treatment of our groups.
- 5. It is important that Sports have a forum for discussion that is able to approve policy changes that only affect their clubs.

Union Resolves

- 1. To amend Appendix B of the Standing Orders of Council to recombine the groups as the Clubs, Societies and Projects Board (CSPB).
- 2. To recommend CSPB formalises the Sports Hub Exec as a subcommittee of CSPB.
