## The Committee Believes:

- 1. CSPs should only be made inactive as a last resort, when it is clear that the club is not functional as an entity any longer.
- 2. Clubs should be merged with other clubs with a similar core purpose and aims and objectives where possible.
- 3. Dormancy is a useful tool for suspending club activities temporarily, either due to a temporary drop in interest in one academic year, or difficulty in electing a committee during the previous academic year.
