- 2. Whilst these clubs are still listed in eActivities, and continue to have a financial account, they are considered "dead" for all other purposes.
- 3. If a student wishes to restart one of these clubs or start a similar club, it must be done as if it were a new club, including passing through the New Activities Incubator.

The Committee Believes:

- 1. Union funds are best put to work in enabling activity, and not (in real terms) losing value sitting stagnant in the Union's CSP bank account.
- 2. SGI raised by a previous CSP should only be spent on activity related to the purpose of the club it was originally raised by.
- 3. It is appropriate for inactive clubs to be merged into active clubs with a compatible core purpose and aims and objectives to enable the above.

The Committee Resolves:

- 1. Require the Chair to accept suggestions from CSPs on mergers and consult with them on the suitability of any such merger.
- 2. Empower the Chair to take any reasonable requests to the New Activities Committee for approval.
